

KINDERGARTEN ONSITE Specialist (Part 3) ADDITIONAL QUALIFICATION COURSE



The Elementary Teachers' Federation of Ontario is offering this professional learning opportunity for teachers. ETFO has a proven track record for providing high-quality professional learning opportunities for educators across the province of Ontario. This course is designed to extend and deepen the application of concepts discussed in Kindergarten Part 1 and 2. Leadership in assessment and strategies for building collaboration and support within the Kindergarten education community will be examined. Participants will require access to a computer and an Internet connection during the full session of the course.
